Satyagraha is the search for truth and the use of non-violent resistance in the fight against injustice, discrimination and violence.

JANADESH 2007

On October 2nd, 2007, there will be 25 000 people marching from Gwalior to Delhi, an action that has been termed Janadesh - a peoples verdict..

Ekta Parishad, the organizing force behind this movement is based on the Gandhian principals of non-violence and acts as a national body for articulating the disempowered people's aspirations. It mobilized people, especially poor and deprived sections, on the issues of proper and just utilization of livelihood resources, primarily land, but also forest and water.

Ekta Parishad is mobilizing for a New Vision of Land Reform. If there is no action from the Government, 25000 will march.

JANADESH CYCLE YATRA

On January 12th, 2007, 15 youth will begin a journey of 2000km. The Janadesh Cycle Tour will be spreading the message of Janadesh and the importance of leadership in social change as well as carrying the spirit of non-violence to every community it touches.

The team will be promoting the agenda of land and livelihood rights across the route and gathering stories and case studies from each province. They want to spread awareness of injustices such as military expenditures and the importance of redirecting our values. The cycle tour team will be creating solidarity amongst people from different regions and will collect signatures to present to the government in October 2007. During the cycle tour the participants will visit schools and community centers, using art and theatre to share their ideas and motivate youth for non-violent collective action
